(SBPLI) and Zebra Technologies at Hofstra University, these back-to-back regionals feature 85 teams from across Long Island, New York State, the United States, and around the world. The students, aged 14 to 18, utilize 120-pound robots to compete in alliance-style tournament rounds under this year’s challenge. Long Island residents are encouraged to attend to support these local high school students. Guided by mentors, students rely on their skills in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM).
